that *he* be and appear before the Judges of our said Supreme Court, at the next term of said Court, to be holden at *Springfield*, ~~at Van-Sprung~~ in said State, on the *first* Monday in *June* next, to hear the records and proceedings aforesaid, and the errors assigned, if *he* shall think fit; and further to do and receive what the said Court shall order in this behalf; and have you then there the names of those by whom you shall give the said *Mark Aldrich* notice, together with this writ.

Witness, the Hon. William Wilson, Chief Justice of our said Court, and the seal thereof, at *Springfield*, this *3<sup>rd</sup>* day of *February* in the year of our Lord, 18*40*.
