the said plaintiffs by M. Williamson their attorney
and the said defendants by Lindsay and Fowler their
attorneys and the said defendants withdrew their special
pleas filed herein. Whereupon both parties waive a trial
by jury and agree that all matters both of law and
fact arising in this cause should be tried by the
Court. The Court having heard the evidence
in the case and being fully advised in the premises
doth find for the plaintiff and assess his dama-
ge at \$1129.94 Eleven Hundred and Twenty
Nine and 94/100 Dollars. Thereupon the said de

pendants entered their motion for a new trial of this
cause, The Court being fully advised in the premises
doth overule the said motion, Therefore it is con-
sidered by the Court that the said James G. Goodrich
Peter N. Williard and Albert A. Child do have
and recover of and from the said James A. Suth-
erland and Bernard Wagner the sum of \$1129.94
Eleven Hundred and Twenty Nine and
94/100 Dollars their damages aforesaid and also their
costs and charges by them about their suit in this
behalf expended and that they have Execution
therefor. Thereupon the said defendants prayed
an appeal of this cause to the Supreme Court of this
State, which is allowed on their entering into Bonds
in the penal sum of Two Thousand Dollars con-
ditional according to law, within thirty days - Being
to be approved by the Clerk.

Appeal Bond. Know all Men by these Presents, That we
James A. Sutherland as principals, and Elisha J.
Sutherland as Surety are held and firmly bound unto
James G. Goodrich, Peter N. Williard & Albert
A. Child in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars
Dollars for the payment of which well and truly to be
made we, ^{jointly and severally} bind ourselves, our heirs and Executors,
The condition of the above obligation is such, that
whereas at the July Term 1859 of the County Court

of Peoria County State of Illinois the above named
Plaintiffs James G. Goodrich, Peter H. Williard
& Albert A. Child recovered a judgement against
James A. Sutherland and Bernard Wagner for the
sum of One Thousand One Hundred and Twenty
nine Dollars and Ninety Four cents, from which said
judgement said Defendants prayed an Appeal to the
Supreme Court of the State of Illinois; Now if the above
named James A. Sutherland and Bernard Wagner
shall prosecute said appeal to effect and shall pay
said judgement together with all costs, interest & dam-
ages in case said judgement be affirmed by said
Supreme Court then and in that case this obligation
to be ~~void~~ null and void, otherwise to be and remain
in full force and virtue.
