C. Richardson a judgment in said
court in an action of assumpsit
for the sum of three hundred and
ninety two Dollars and fifty
three cents besides costs - that
at said term the said John Wassack
and William C. Richardson prayed
an appeal to the Supreme court
from said judgment, which
appeal was allowed by said county
court on condition that said Wassack
and Richardson should file an
appeal bond in said case in
the penal sum of six hundred
dollars with Elias Richardson
as security, within thirty days

from the rising of said county
court, and that the appeal bond
required by said order was executed
and filed within the time prescribed
by said order - all of which
