"I do hereby enter myself security for Costs in this Cause

"And acknowledge myself bound to pay or cause to be
"paid, All costs which may accrue in this action, either
"to the opposite party or to any of the Officers of this Court,
"in pursuance of the laws of this State, and more especial
"any Courts that may accrue and legally devolve upon said
"Minor Complainants. — Jacksonville, Dec. 22^d 1859
"David A. Smith"

Affiant further states that no part of the costs of the
above Cause in the Circuit Court aforesaid, and no
part of the costs in the aforesaid Cause in this Court,
has yet been paid — Wherefore Affiant prays an
Order by this Court that execution or fee bill, as
provided by Statute may issue against the said
David A. Smith, or against the said Defendants
and the said David A. Smith for the costs recovered
by this Affiant as aforesaid. — Edw. M. B. Clarke
