Know all men by these presents that we James Beall
John D. Beall Charles Nick and Augustus
G.S. Wright of the County of Gallatin and State of Illinois
are here and firmly bound unto James M. Duncan
Clerk of the Supreme Court of the said State of
Illinois in the penal sum of thirty five dollars
lawful money of the United States the payment
whereof well and truly to be made we bind
our selves our heirs each of our joint and
several heirs Executors and administrators
Solemnly swearing and firmly by these presents
sealed with our seals and dated this 25th
day of August A.D. 1824.

Whereas the said James M. Duncan Clerk
as aforesaid in the suit of the said James &
John D. Beall against ~~Charles Nick~~ ^{Charles Nick} Syddet of the
County and State of Indiana, rendered his
feebill amounting to sixteen dollars and
eighty two cents for his costs in said suit
against said Bealls ^{Charles Nick} and put into my hands
as the Sheriff of the said Gallatin County
for collection and the same hath been duly
levied and they pray that the same may
be repaid (as specie is demanded, agreeably
to the statute of said State in such cases
made and provided and tenders this
bond with Augustus G.S. Wright their security.

Now if the said James & John D. Bealls
and Charles Nick shall well and truly pay
the said sum of ~~sixteen~~ ^{fifty} dollars & eighty two
cents amount of said feebill, fifty cents

for living. Fifty cents for this bond eighty
four cents mileage, and nine cents for
returning said public. Amounting in
the whole to ~~Eighty dollars~~ and twenty
five cents within three years from the
date hereof or August 25. 1851. If their security
shall do it for them then this obligation
to be void otherwise to be and remain
in full force and virtue in law.
