that *they* be and appear before the Justices of our said Supreme Court, at the next term of said Court to be holden at Springfield, in said State, on the *2* Monday in *December* next to hear the records and proceedings aforesaid, and the errors assigned, if *they* shall think fit; and further to do and receive what the said Court shall order in this behalf; and have you then and there the names of those by whom you shall give the said *Defendants in Error* notice, together with this writ.
