sworn and after hearing the evidence
and after receiving instructions from the Court they retired
to consider of their verdict and it is ordered by the
Court by agreement of the parties by their attorneys that
the jury when they shall have agreed upon their verdict may
sign and seal the same and deliver it to the Clerk.

The jury yesterday empanelled
in this case, returned into
Court this morning with the
following verdict to wit: We the jury find the defendants
guilty in manner and form as charged in the Complaint
It is therefore considered by the Court that the Plaintiff
have restitution of the claim described in the Complaint
and that he have and recover of the defendants his costs
by him about his suit in this behalf expended and also

his costs in the Court below and that he have execution
therefor. And the defendants by their Attorney pray an
appeal to the Supreme Court

The appeal heretofore prayed
for by the defendants by their
Attorney is granted by the
Court conditioning that the said defendants enter
into bond with Edward Green as their security in
the sum of One hundred dollars within ten days
from the rising of the present term of this Court.

Appeal Bond

Know all men by these presents that we David O
Reilly, Morris Dynam and Lawrence Ryan and Edward
Green of the County of St Clair and State of Illinois are
held and firmly bound unto William P Green also
of the same County and State in the penal sum of
One hundred Dollars current money of the United
States for the payment of which well and truly to be made
we bind ourselves our heirs, executors and administrators
jointly severally and firmly by these presents. Witness
our hands and seals this fourth day of December A.D.
1841

The condition of the above obligation is
such that whereas the said William P Green did
on the twenty fourth day of November A.D. 1841 in the Circuit
Court in and for the County and State aforesaid recover
a judgment against the above bounden David O
Reilly, Morris Dynam and Lawrence Ryan for the possession
of a claim of land and also for the sum of twenty
dollars and thirteen cents costs from which said

judgment of the said Circuit Court the said Daniel
O'Reilly, Morris Dryman and Lawrence Ryan have prayed
for and obtained an appeal to the Supreme Court of
said State. Now if the said Daniel O'Reilly, Morris
Dryman and Lawrence Ryan shall duly prosecute their
said appeal with effect and shall moreover pay the
Amount of the judgment costs interest and damages
rendered and to be rendered against them in case
the said judgment shall be affirmed in the said
Supreme Court, then the above obligation shall be void
otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
