The People of the State of Illinois,

To the Sheriff of *Madison* County.

BECAUSE in the record and proceedings, and also in the rendition of the judgment, of plea which was in the Circuit Court of *Madison* County, before the Judge thereof, between *William E. Stow* Plaintiff and *Henry Stow* —

*feld* defendant it is said that manifest error hath intervened to the injury of the said *defendant* as we are informed by *his* complaint, the record and proceedings of which said judgment, we have caused to be brought into our Supreme Court of the State of Illinois, at *Vern-Sprung* ~~date~~, before the Judges thereof, to correct the errors in the same, in due form and manner, according to law; therefore we command you, that by good and lawful men of your county, you give notice to the said *William E. Stow* —

that *he* be and appear before the Judges of our said Supreme Court, at the next term of said Court, to be holden at ~~Vandalia~~ <sup>*Springfield*</sup> in said State, on the *3<sup>rd</sup>* Monday in *June* next ~~next~~, to hear the records and proceedings aforesaid, and the errors assigned, if *he* shall think fit; and further to do and receive what the said Court shall order in this behalf; and have you then there the names of those by whom you shall give the said *William E. Stow* notice, together with this writ.
