The People of the State of Illinois,

TO THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF Clark COUNTY, GREETING

Whereas in a certain plea between Mesley Jones assignee of Allen Guffitt & Remondus R Guffitt plaintiff; and David Scott

Clark defendant, lately depending in the Circuit Court of said county of Clark wherein judgment was rendered for the said Mesley Clark assignee and against the said David Scott and the said

David Scott has brought up by writ of Error the judgment of said court, rendered against him as aforesaid, to the Supreme Court, held at Springfield, on the first Monday in June 1840 and in pursuance of the said writ of Error a transcript of the record and the proceedings in the plea aforesaid was transmitted. And also whereas it hath been suggested, on the part of said

that the said record has been diminished, in as much as a complete and true Record hath not been sent up; and for as much as the said Supreme Court are not satisfied that there is a sufficient record sent in the plea aforesaid, but in the record there is a diminution; you are therefore hereby commanded, that without delay the said Record therein, you cause to be transmitted to the said Supreme Court, now Springfield to be held at Vandalia, on the forthwith ~~next~~, without any diminution or addition whatsoever, to the end that speedy justice may be done in the premises, according to law; whereof you are in no wise to fail; and send you then there this writ.
