was filed in this Court at the Dec Term
1848 ~~and~~ was copied by the Plaintiff in
Error and the Clerk of Cathlamet Circuit
Court under an agreement between said
Pff in Error and said Clerk as this affia-
nt is informed by the Pff in Error, that
under said agreement the Clerk was to
aid in copying and to compose the
transcript and certify the same and
charge a specified amount for such
labor, that the Pff in Error himself copied
about two thirds ^{of said transcript} ~~for~~ the Clerk the balance and
the Pff in Error paid the Clerk
thirty ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for his services as per
agreement - The affiant further de-
poses that according to his computa-
tion the legal fees for copying said
transcript are fifty seven ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ dollars
and that the amount taxed is only
thirty ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars - being the sum
paid the clerk by said Pff in Error -
Subscribed and sworn to before E Keating -
Me. This 24th July 1850 W. B. Warner

in Error moves the Court to direct
a retaxing of the fee bill and that fifty
seven ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ dollars - be taxed for the copy of the
