### Death of Chief Justice Wilson.

A gentleman in this city on yesterday from Carmi informs us of the death of Judge WILLIAM WILSON. He died at his residence in White county on the 29th ult., in about the 65th year of his life. Judge WILSON was one of the early pioneers of Illinois, and was Chief Justice of the Supreme Court from 1819 to 1849, when the new Constitution was adopted. This position he filled with marked ability, as the reports of that court give ample testimony. In all his relations, social and official, he was a most estimable man, universally respected.
